

# Martin Luther King Jr. Student Contest 2017

## Guidelines for submitting student entries for 2017 MLK contest

Thank you for participating in Springfield's 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration and Student Contest. This year the Celebration, honoring Dr. King and Contest participants will be held at Springfield High School on Monday, January 16<sup>th</sup> 2017.

**Entry labels:** Please complete the enclosed, self-sticking entry label to go on the back of each entry. In addition to writing student info on the label, please write the student's name, grade, and school on the **front** of each entry.

**Artwork entries only:** please have each student **attach an index card** briefly describing how his/her artwork relates to the theme *"Love transforms enemies into friends"* The student's name should be included on the index card. Attach the **self-sticking entry label** to the **back** of the artwork, including student's name, grade, and school.

**Small group projects:** Each student should fill out and attach a self-sticking entry label.

**Entire class:** If you are entering a class project, we ask that you include a **class list** of participating students.

### **Student information needs to be complete and legible.**

**Grades K-3:** Every participating student in grades K-3 will receive a participation ribbon.

**Deadline for Grades K-3 entries:** K-3 entries need to be delivered **Friday, January 13<sup>th</sup>** to Willamalane Center, 250 S. 32<sup>nd</sup> Street **by 6 p.m.**

**Grades 4-12:** Winning entries for students in grades 4 through 12, will receive cash prizes. All student information needs to be accurate on each entry so that winning students and their families can be contacted. All winners are encouraged to attend the Martin Luther King Day Celebration on January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and be recognized.

**Deadline for Grades 4-12 entries:** entries need to be delivered Tuesday, **January 10<sup>th</sup>** to Willamalane Center, 250 S. 32<sup>nd</sup> Street **by 6 p.m.**
