Our Angel Tree Christmas program includes a food box for the household as well as toys for all children 17 & under! In order to apply and qualify for our program, please visit the local branch and bring the following:

- Valid ID (Passport/Driver's License) for all adults in household.
- Proof of all income, including: Pay Stubs, Child Support, TANF, SNAP/Food Stamps, SSI/SSD, DHS Printouts/Award Letters for benefits, Etc.
- Legal documentation showing your child's full name and date of birth, including: Birth Certificates, Immunization Records, DHS Printouts, Etc.

The deadline for our Angel Tree program has been extended, but still ends soon! Your application and qualifying information must be submitted by December 15th by 3pm. There is a quota for this program, and if the quota is met before the 15th, our program will no longer accept applications.

Applications are only available at: The Salvation Army Springfield, located at 1275 Mill St. Office hours are Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9am-12pm and 1pm-3pm. Wednesday hours are 9am-11am and 1:30pm-3pm. Monday we are closed. We hope that all in our community enjoy a safe, cheerful holidays!
